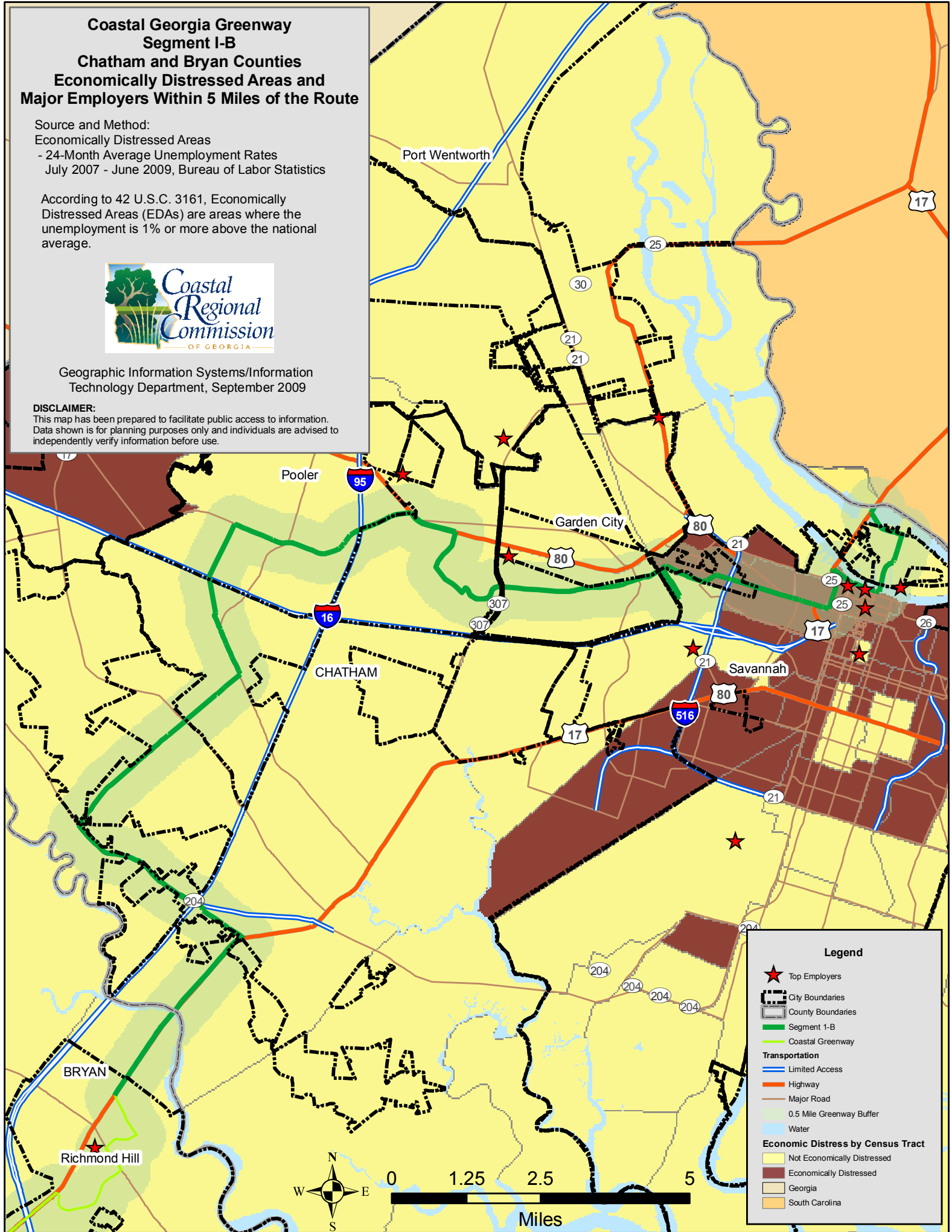
According to 42 U.S.C. 3161, Economically Distressed Areas (EDAs) are areas where the unemployment is 1% or more above the national average.
