Most of the route uses the E-W ab Rail Corridor, which begins on Spur 40 at at the Kings Bay Submarine Base and heads West crossing Colerain road near the Lakewood Baptist Church on a westward heading toward the PSA Recreation Center. Another route splintered off the corridor to Gilligans Island recreation area, which appears to be an easy route to implement.
